CIRSA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

To assist members in furthering their risk management education, CIRSA will provide **\$12,000** in funding for scholarship awards in 2022. Virtual and in-person events are eligible for funding. Available scholarships include:

- National Conference Awards up to \$2,250
 per award. Member employees may apply the
 award to a professional development symposium
 related to safety, continuing education, or risk
 management. Examples include, but are not
 limited to: <u>Risk and Insurance Management Society</u>
 (RIMS), <u>Public Risk Management Association</u>
 (PRIMA), <u>International City/County Management
 Association (ICMA)</u>, <u>Government Finance Officers
 Association (GFOA)</u>, and the <u>International Institute
 of Municipal Clerks (IIMC)</u>.
- Colorado Institute for Municipal Clerks Awards up to \$1,500 per award. Member employees may apply the award to registration, lodging, and other travel expenses needed to attend the <u>CMCA</u> <u>Institute & Academy</u>.
- Local Conference Awards up to \$600 per award. Intended to provide financial support to member employees to attend in-state conferences and meetings. Examples include, but are not limited to: the Colorado Government Finance Officers Association (CGFOA), Colorado Municipal Clerks Association (CMCA), Colorado PRIMA (COPRIMA) or Colorado Municipal League (CML) Conferences.

For 2022, CIRSA has donated funds towards CCCMA Conference scholarships directly to CCCMA. CCCMA, not CIRSA, will be responsible for awarding scholarships for the conference. Apply on the <u>CCCMA website</u>.

RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

CIRSA will reimburse the <u>member entity</u> of each scholarship recipient for their expenses to attend the conference of their choice. Recipients must submit receipts for each qualifying expense (registration fees, lodging, transportation, and meals) incurred and will be reimbursed a maximum of the award amount. If the total award amount is not needed, unused funds will be kept in the Scholarship Program to be used for future awards.

APPLY

Recipients will be responsible for funding the expenses not covered by the award. This scholarship is not transferable and CIRSA will not provide reimbursement if the designated recipient is not able to attend the conference.

Scholarships will be awarded prior to the conference date and scholarship recipients will be asked to complete an evaluation of their conference experience.
