ADA PLAYGROUND ACCESSIBILITY TRAINING



On September 15, 2010, the Department of Justice (DOJ), published the revised regulations for Title II and Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. These regulations adopted and revised the enforceable accessibility standards, called the "2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design."

These standards set minimum requirements for scoping and technical requirements for newly designed, constructed, or altered state and local government facilities. All public accommodations and commercial facilities must be readily accessible for use by individuals with disabilities.

CIRSA's ADA Playground Accessibility training will focus on how these standards apply to the accessibility of the playground and usability

of playground equipment by individuals with disabilities. Items of discussion include:

- Ramps
- Transfer Platforms
- Play equipment

- Accessible Surfacing Materials
