## Lithium-Ion Battery Safety

Purchase batteries from a reputable manufacturer or supplier.

Stop using the battery if you notice an odor, change in color, too much heat, change in shape, leaking, or odd noises, and remove it from service.

Store batteries away from combustible materials.

Recycle with a certified battery electronics recycler.

Lithium-ion batteries contain a small amount of lithium metal; in case of a fire, they can be doused with

water. Lithium-metal batteries, on the other hand, require a Class D fire extinguisher.

Ensure that workers who use or handle lithiumpowered devices, cells, or batteries are adequately trained.
