EV Charging Stations

Before installation, an onsite evaluation should be performed.

Refer to the manufacturer's specifications and guidelines for installing EV charging stations.

Only licensed electricians and contractors should perform installation, maintenance, and repairs.

Never store or use flammable, explosive, or combustible vapors or gases near the stations.

Install bollards to protect the EV stations.

Develop a maintenance and inspection plan to ensure optimal performance year-round.

Periodically inspect the EV cable/connector and all other wiring and connections for cracks, broken or missing pieces, and exposed wires.

Make sure all safety and parking signs are legible and installed correctly.
