# AQUATICS RISK MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

With warmer temperatures just around the corner, our local pools will soon be full of people trying to escape the summer heat. Our Aquatic Risk Management Seminar is designed to help keep communities safe while reducing the risk of pool related liabilities. Dr. Rachel Griffiths, with Aquatic Safety Research Group, will cover general information about risk management and aquatic risk management, limitations of supervision and supervising lifeguards, and how to strengthen supervision. She will address some specific risks like diving, shallow water blackout, and protecting little ones. Information about educating the public, as well as warnings, documentation, and liability, will be included. The presentation includes drowning videos and other short videos. Dr. Griffiths will also include new and "hot" topics like lifeguard shortages and medical events/substance use deaths in the water.
